Ridgewood High School at a Glance

Ridgewood High School was founded in 1892 and is a comprehensive high school for grades 9-12, with a present school population of 1750. The high school is one of the largest in Bergen County and is consistently ranked among the top public high schools in New Jersey. The academic environment is rigorous with a robust, multidimensional curriculum offering.

Outside of the classroom, Ridgewood High School features a vibrant and comprehensive extracurricular program. Our music, arts, and dance programs are all exceptional and have received accolades and recognition at the state and national level. In 2023, our Athletic Programs won a record breaking 29 state championships, the most in New Jersey.

Ridgewood, New Jersey, is an incorporated village with a population of approximately 26,000 and is located in Bergen County, 16 miles from New York City. The citizens maintain a high level of interest in the education system, often moving to Ridgewood for the quality of the education system. The expenditure per pupil for the 2022-2023 school year was \$16,563. Presently, 85% of the school's certified staff have earned Master's Degrees or higher.

Freshman Year Philosophy

At Ridgewood High School, an intentional focus is placed on student well-being, mental health, and balance. For incoming 9th grade students, all students take college preparatory level courses with the exception of students who double accelerate in mathematics. Course level options are purposely limited to college prep level courses to allow our 9th grade students to transition to high school. Our Freshman F.O.C.U.S. Program is a one-of-a-kind peer model orientation program that lasts until April and offers students additional support and mentorship.
